ACTIVITIES

ACTIVITY 1

- Taking photos of other workshops while participants are working on the activities
- Selection of best photos
- Presentation of some famous photographers. Annie Leibovitz. She photographed famous people and striking situations: The rolling Stones, Olympic Athletes in Atlanta 1996, Wars etc. Annie is a living legend of photography

ACTIVITY 2

- Participants move around the camp and:
 - Take photos of some of the participants. Before taking the photo, participants carry out a short interview on personal information. (where they are from, occupation, family, likes and dislikes etc). Participants write the info down in a piece of paper and take a picture of it.
- Picture exhibition. Attendants try to guess about the personal details of the photographed person. Then, the person who took the photo provides the information taken from the interview. Comparison of guesses and true answers.

ACTIVITY 3 - TRIBUTE TO BOB DYLAN

Dylan`s lyrics deal with social, political, philosophical and literary issues which challenge conventional pop music and traditional cultural idiosyncrasy. He is 75 and still a rebel.

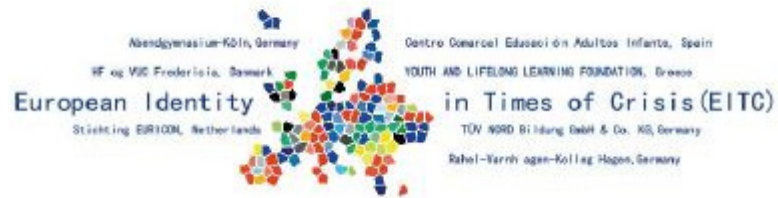
- Take photos of a Dylan`s verse
